

Call for Proposals for Visiting Teaching Staff

Possible timing: Between October 2018 and early April 2019

Duration: 2 to 3 days per teaching activity

Topics that could be covered:

<u>Technical modules</u>: IT, Computer science, Software Engineering.

<u>Soft skills</u>: Personal development, Project management, Business (introduction), law (introduction), innovation.

Target population of students: 5th-year (final year) students of the 5 years Epitech program leading to the Epitech Graduate Diploma in Information Technology.

Format of the teaching activity:

2 to 3-days Seminars mostly focused on practical approach like vocational training seminars for working professionals.

Technical modules

Day 1:

AM: presentation of the technical domain/subject. Introduction about basic or more advanced concepts. 1.30 to 2 hours + session of Q&A.

PM: practical assignments. Q&A.

Day 2:

Different formats may be chosen:

- -Brainstorming
- -Launching of the project
- -Workshop/practical assignment.

Day 3:

AM: Workshop/Practical assignment in group/Coworking

PM: Different formats may be chosen:

- -Afternoon free
- -Possibility of launching of 1-3 weeks project
- -Evaluation:
 - On the basis of attendance
 - Multiple Choice Questionnaire
 - Oral Pitch
 - Other?

Soft skills

Instructors may choose between two formats:

Workshops & Pitch

The instructor introduces the topic and then is monitoring a workshop, by taking a specific case as an example.

From Day One to Day Three: conferences and workshops followed by a pitch in the afternoon of the Day 3.

Day 1:

Introduction of the topic by the instructor (for example, launching of the company).

From Day 1 (evening) to Day 3:

Contests among the students (ex. Simulation of the start-up). Project Rush / Crunch Time Project (students have limited time to work on a challenging project).

Day 3, PM:

Pitch and announcement of the contest's results.

Other Information:

The flight and accommodation, near the campus, are provided by EPITECH

A taxi will be waiting at the airport to drive you to the hotel.

Lunch will be provided at the School and dinner will be served at your hotel.

An invitation letter and a certificate if needed will be provided for the duration of the given course.
