Open access and IOP Publishing

We have been a pioneer in open access (OA) publishing, launching the first fully OA physics journal in 1998. Since then we have launched several more OA journals, introduced OA options for authors in our subscription journals, and more recently developed ground-breaking licence agreements with institutions and funders to facilitate their move towards OA publishing.

This agreement is another landmark in the transformation of scholarly publishing from subscription to open access.

IOP's OA policy offers authors:

- Options for gold OA on most journals.
- Self-archiving of the accepted version of an article (green OA) after a minimum 12-month embargo period on all journals.
- An easy-to-use article publication charge portal.
- CC BY as our standard license for gold OA allowing us to be compatible with the majority of OA mandates.
- Discoverability for OA papers on search engines and in the major indexing services.

IOP's OA policy offers librarians:

- The reassurance that **no one pays twice** article publication charges are taken into account when setting subscription prices.
- Ongoing **engagement** with the whole scientific community to seek practical solutions that will both increase access to research and preserve the integrity of the scientific record.
