Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) is a term frequently used in business and finance to describe the success of a firm in three major areas.

They include the company's environmental effect, its treatment of employees and investors, and its general corporate governance standards.ESG-focused investments prioritise ethical and sustainable operations in addition to financial gains. There is mounting emphasis on firms to emphasise social good when making decisions regarding their operations. In this way, ESG data may assist organisations in measuring and monitoring their sustainability







KPIs. Adopting good environmental and social policies has been demonstrated to be essential for long-term success.

Description: In the context of the recent global COVID-19 pandemic and global transformations such as ageing, digitalisation, climate change and rising inequalities, cities and regions worldwide have swiftly stepped in to generate economic growth, and an inclusive recovery. Universities are playing a key role supporting these efforts. Many universities have been providing scientific and technical support to policy makers in their cities and regions to adopt digital technologies and scientific methods to monitor and reduce their environmental footprint, as well as to improve urban planning and regional industrial strategies, including smart specialization. Entrepreneurial universities generate incubators, accelerators and other entities promoting connection and collaboration within their communities and networks (ecosystems). Practices are emerging in different countries, and prove the value of the triple (quadruple, quintuple) helix framework. However, universities face challenges related to the lack of capacities, incentives, and resources. To leverage HEIs in the context of the sustainability agenda, new policy complementarities and synergies are needed to favour entrepreneurship, co-specialization and impact. The semi plenary session will engage international experts and practitioners, and will also connect to the new OECD EECOLE platform, which facilitates an international policy dialogue that gives visibility to the new function of HEIs in our complex societies.
