



VILNIUS STUDENT SPORTS FESTIVAL BADMINTON TOURNAMENT

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To popularise the badminton sport among students of Vilnius city higher education institutions and to promote their physical activity.
2. To seek cooperation between Vilnius city higher education institutions and their communities.
3. Create conditions for competition and development.
4. Clarify and reward the best players in the tournament.

ORGANISATION AND EXECUTION

1. The tournament is organised by the Centre for Health and Sports of the Vilnius Academy of Arts.
2. Gediminas Technical University contributes to the organisation of the tournament.
3. The tournament is part of the programme of the Vilnius Student Sports Festival.
4. The system for conducting the competition will depend on the number of registered participants. Units will be played to find out the personal capacity of the students, then divided into two groups according to the capacity, the players of the weaker group will draw the pairer from the stronger group by lot, and mixed doubles, men's doubles, and women's doubles will be played.
5. The competition is judged by the athletes who have previously lost the competition.

TIME AND PLACE

1. The competition will be held on 7th of October, 2023. (Saturday) in Vilnius, in the gym of the Vilnius Academy of Arts, Malūnų str. 5., Vilnius, Lithuania
2. The competition starts at 9:00 a.m.

PARTICIPANTS

1. The tournament is open to students of Vilnius city higher education institutions, as well as guest students of higher education institutions of other cities.
2. Participants are responsible for their own health throughout the tournament.
