RESOLUTION ON THE APPROVAL OF THE CRITERIA FOR THE UNIVERSITY GRADUATION DIPLOMA 'WITH HONORS', DIPLOMA 'CUM LAUDE' AND DIPLOMA 'MAGNA CUM LAUDE'

In accordance with the Guidelines for Completing the Higher Education Diploma Supplement approved by the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Lithuania No. V-362 of 15 May 2017, the Senate of Vilnius Gediminas Technical University resolves:

To approve the following criteria for university graduation diplomas:

- 1. Diploma 'With Honors' is awarded:
- 1.1. to a student who has completed all final assessments of study subjects (modules) and received grades not lower than 'good', with a weighted average of not lower than 9.5, and who has been awarded a grade of 'Very good' or 'Excellent' in the final thesis or the final examination(s);
- 1.2. to a student of the Master of Business Administration (MBA) study program who has completed all final assessments of study subjects (modules) and received grades not lower than 'good', and a weighted average of grades not lower than 9.5.
- 2. Diploma 'Cum Laude' is awarded to a student who had completed the study program exceptionally well: all final assessments of study subjects (modules) have been completed with grades no lower than 'Very good', and a weighted average of grades not lower than 9.75, and whose final thesis or final examination(s) have been graded 'Excellent'.
- 3. Diploma 'Magna Cum Laude' is awarded to a student who had completed the study program exceptionally well: all final assessments of study subjects (modules) have been completed with grades no lower than 'Very good', and a weighted average of grades not lower than 9.75, and whose final thesis or final examination(s) have been graded 'Excellent' and who has revealed scientific abilities (published at least two scientific articles in scientific journals, or demonstrated their professional or artistic activity: participated in a national or international competition and received an award for a project or work of art).
