RECTOR'S ORDER REGARDING ORGANIZATION AND EXECUTION OF THE SUDY PROCESS OF 2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

July 4, 2025 No. 10.8-679 Vilnius

I establish that:

- 1. For students of the first cycle of full-time studies and integrated studies, all classes are organised in person on the university premises.
- 2. For students of postgraduate full-time studies and all types of part-time studies, up to 50% of the volume of studies can be organised remotely; final assessments are to be held in person.
- 3. Full-time studies of all cycles conducted in English for first-year international students may be carried out in a hybrid way until November 1, if students are unable to enter for justifiable reasons (such as not having obtained a temporary residence permit in Lithuania).
- 4. For second-cycle full-time international students, studies and final assessments are conducted in person only.
- 5. Theoretical lectures are compulsory for full-time first, second and third-year students. Attendance at more than half of the lectures is required per semester. Lecture attendance is indicated on the course/module card and recorded in the Moodle virtual learning environment.
- 6. Starting from September 1, 2025, lecturers at the Lithuanian Maritime Academy must use the Moodle virtual learning environment for their courses.
- 7. College studies at the Lithuanian Maritime Academy may be carried out in a hybrid way if the study subject(s) are taught by lecturers from other VILNIUS TECH faculties located in Vilnius.
